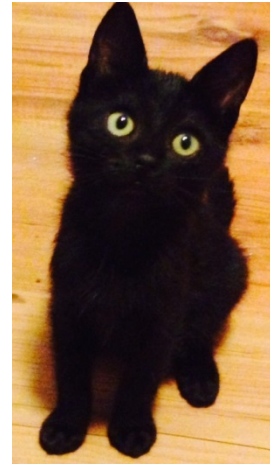


**Hope 4 Paws: Grant County

Spay & Neuter Assistance
for cats and older kittens**



If you are in need of financial help to spay or neuter your cat, Hope 4 Paws: Grant County, in cooperation with John Day River Vet Clinic, is offering spay & neuter assistance for cats and older kittens* owned by residents of Grant County.

- **A \$20 discount can be applied towards the cost of the basic surgery for a cat spay or cat neuter!**

To receive your assistance voucher, please ask at your Veterinarians reception desk when you bring your pet in for an appointment. Fill out the short application form and the \$20 discount will be applied to your bill.

The discount must be applied to the bill at the time of service, so sorry, no retroactive vouchers can be given.

***Recommended ages: Spay female kittens no later than 4 to 5 months old, male kittens at 6 to 7 months old to prevent unwanted pregnancy or nuisance behavior (spraying, fighting, roaming, etc.) For strays, or feral animals, other resources may be available, and can be discussed on a case by case basis.**

Note: Our discount program is made possible through the generous support of donors and grants to Hope 4 Paws: Grant County, and will continue as long as funding is available. To allow us to help as many as possible- **limit 4 vouchers (cat/dog combined) per household/year.**
